- Any **sibling** of a current camper is eligible for a \$25 sibling discount per session.

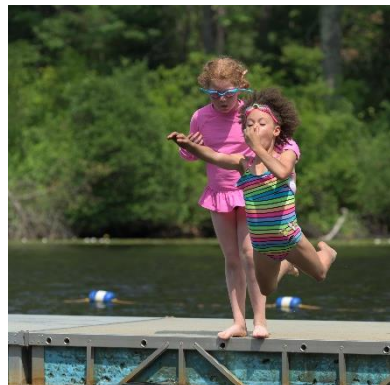
Financial Aid and Payment Plans

Our 2019 **financial aid** deadline has passed. If you are ready to register, but are unable to pay in full by May 1, camp may be paid for in multiple installments with a **payment plan**. All fees are due in full by the first day of whatever session your camper is enrolled in. Email Calder Akin at cakin@halereservation.org to coordinate a plan.

Tax Credits

In years past, the IRS made a **Child and Dependent Care Credit** available to working parents who needed to arrange for care of their children (under 13 years of age) during school vacations. The cost of day camp (but not overnight camp) could have been counted as an expense toward that credit, and the credit could have been up to 35% of qualifying expenses, depending on income. Parents could have claimed up to \$3,000 of unreimbursed expenses paid in a year for one qualifying individual, or \$6,000 for two or more qualifying individuals.

Transportation

Hale Day Camp is pleased to provide **free bus transportation** for Brookline, Dedham, Dover, Jamaica Plain, Medfield, Needham, Newton, Norwood, West Roxbury, Walpole, Wellesley, and Westwood. Please see below for stop locations. A Hale Day Camp staff member accompanies each bus for the duration of its route and ensures your camper's safe journey to and from camp each day. Campers may sign up for one of five buses at the time of registration.
